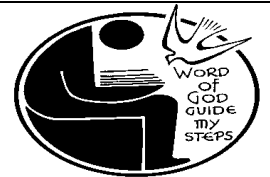
We welcome all who join us to worship at the cathedral. Please join us for tea or coffee after the 8am & 9.30am eucharists.
