ANZAC Commemoration Service – This year marks 100 years of ANZAC Commemoration Services at the Cathedral.

There are many items of significance at the Cathedral. The Cathedral is the principal war memorial of Newcastle City & the Hunter Region. It houses significant national WWI treasures, including the only flag from the Gallipoli campaign and the only Victoria Cross from WWI accessible to the public in NSW, the rest being held privately or at the Australian War Memorial.

- TOURS followed by ANZAC prayers in the Warrior Chapel at 8.30 & 9am and half hourly from 1pm- 4pm
