Dear Parish Family

We had the first of this year's Advent Evensong Preaching Series last Sunday evening, where Mrs Kerrie Duffey from the Parish of Telarah-Rutherford spoke to us about what Christmas looks like to someone who is homeless. This week, the Reverend Jenny Foley, one of the Anglican Care chaplains, will speak to us about Christmas for residents, staff, and families. Evensong is always beautiful, and this preaching series gives us much on which to reflect.

This week the Cathedral hosted the annual Carol Service for Newcastle Grammar School. It was also the last 'chapel' for the Head of School, Mrs Erica Thomas. Please hold Erica in your prayers and she takes up the position of Head of School at Kincoppal Rose Bay. On Thursday of this week, Ms Catherine Wilkinson, Chair of the NGS Board, made the following announcement:

With Mrs Thomas departing at the end of the term, current Deputy Head Dr Alan Parsons will step into the role of Acting Head for the first semester of 2023.

Please also pray for Mr Matthew Macoustra and Dr Alan Parsons and the staff and students of Newcastle Grammar School through this time of transition. On Sunday this weekend you'll find Susan Edwards at the Mary MacKillop Pastoral Centre at Charlestown, where she has been invited to hold a Cathedral Shop stall. If you're around there on Sunday, please pop in and say hello! Susan is also always keen to welcome new volunteers to the team – please contact her if you would like to help out. 


