Finally, this week's poem is another by R S Thomas. I figured we could have an R S Thomas Advent! This poem shows its age (and ours too!) in the refence to hearing the dial tone – a thing fast passing in the age of mobiles. Yet Thomas' desire to speak to God is an eternal desire. I am reminded of Jimmy Little's song, Royal Telephone, and of a person I knew who struggled with life, and sang this song as comfort.

### **Calling**

The telephone is the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. We may call everyone up on it but God.

To do that is to declare that he is far off. Dialling zero is nothing other than the negation of his presence.

So many times I have raised the receiver, listening to that smooth sound that is technology's purring; and the temptation

has come to experiment with the code which would put me through to the divine snarl at the perimeter of such tameness.




