About the illusic

It's the 'silly season' - an exhausting, nauseating marathon of end-of-year parties, commerce-gone-mad and bad television. But the church calendar has a different idea. Advent is a time for waiting - waiting for the celebration of Christmas, but also waiting on the promise of Christ's return. Like Lent, Advent is a time for sacrifice and self-denial, preparing for the feast of Christmas. Our music reflects this, not only in the choice of texts, but also in the choice of musical style. There is a tradition in some European churches that the doors of the organ are closed and locked at the beginning of Advent, depriving the congregation of the rich, comforting and uplifting sounds of the organ until it appears again in Christmas Day. We will not shut the doors of the organ, but there will be less organ playing and more plainsong - beautiful music that consists of just a single melodic line. There will be a wealth of great English music, including William Byrd, Thomas Tallis, Thomas Morley and Henry Purcell. A highlight, and breaking the 'no-organ' rule will be David Drury's magificent Magnificat and Nunc dimittis - a setting based on plainsong with an organ part that lifts the roof off the building.
