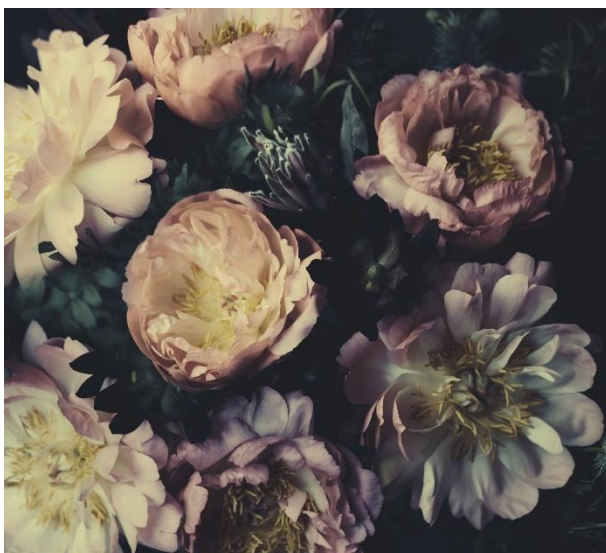

# Ten Commitments for Prevention and Response to Domestic and Family Violence

in the Anglican Church of Australia

1. Our Church acknowledges and commits to the harm which it has been suffered by some of our members and respects that harm as having played a part in allowing an environment where violence went unchallenged.

2. Our Church supports our role as an agent of mission that supports the protection of victims, a Church culture that promotes equality, and support for those with experience of violence.

3. Our Church is committed to work to abuse reporting, boundary setting, respectful relationships and the building of safe spaces.

4. Our Church affirms that human relationships are to be founded on respect and equality.

5. Our Church acknowledges the affected experience of all people and that these have played a part in what we have been involved in in respect of equality.

6. Our Church is aware and directed by the impact of law, power and justice, and we affirm our role in respect of legal, social, health and national government measures in response to violence.

7. Our Church supports all our groups in our communities by ensuring that all people in our systems.

9. Our leaders and pastoral staff hold the nation to account and are guided by the Anglican Church's Code of Conduct, Pastoral Care in Service.

8. Our Church trains our leaders, pastoral staff and parish councils to understand and be equipped to respond in ways that prevent and address domestic and family violence.

10. These commitments are regularly reviewed and improved.
