A highlight of this week's music is the beautiful Missa L'Hora Pass, by the Italian composer Ludovico Viadana. A Franciscan friar, Viadana was one of the foremost composers of his day, and his music straddles the transition from the Renaissance to the Baroque.

Top End Music Tour – Oct 16-20

We are very excited to announce a music tour to the Top End (Bamaga and Thursday Island), under the umbrella of the Cathedral and directed by David Banney. Bamaga and Thursday Island are remote indigenous communities, and it is wonderful that we have an opportunity to connect to them through music.

For the tour, David Banney will be joined by Rosemary Ponnekanti, who is well known to us as organist and chorister, and Rosemary's daughter Bianca, who is a fine violinist.

The tour will include school concerts and public concerts in Bamaga and Thursday Island, as well as music teaching in the primary and secondary schools in Bamaga.

As you say each line, slide the bead along the string.

When you end all the beads and the cross are held in your hand, as you meditate.
