## **Music notes...**

This special day brings to an end the sequence of Advent (waiting), Christmas (birth of Jesus) and Epiphany (revealing Jesus to the world). On this day we celebrate the role of Mary and the presentation of the infant Jesus in the temple, which was the occasion of the meeting with Simeon (of *Nunc dimittis* fame) and Anna. The Eucharist concludes with the congregation reaffirming the vows taken at baptism. These events have inspired some of the most beautiful of all church music, and our music today includes Stanford's wonderful Magnificat and *Nunc dimittis*, Rachmaninoff's exquisite Bogoroditsye dyevo ('Blessed art Thou among women') and Parry's epic anthem 'I was glad when they said to me let us go the house of the Lord'.

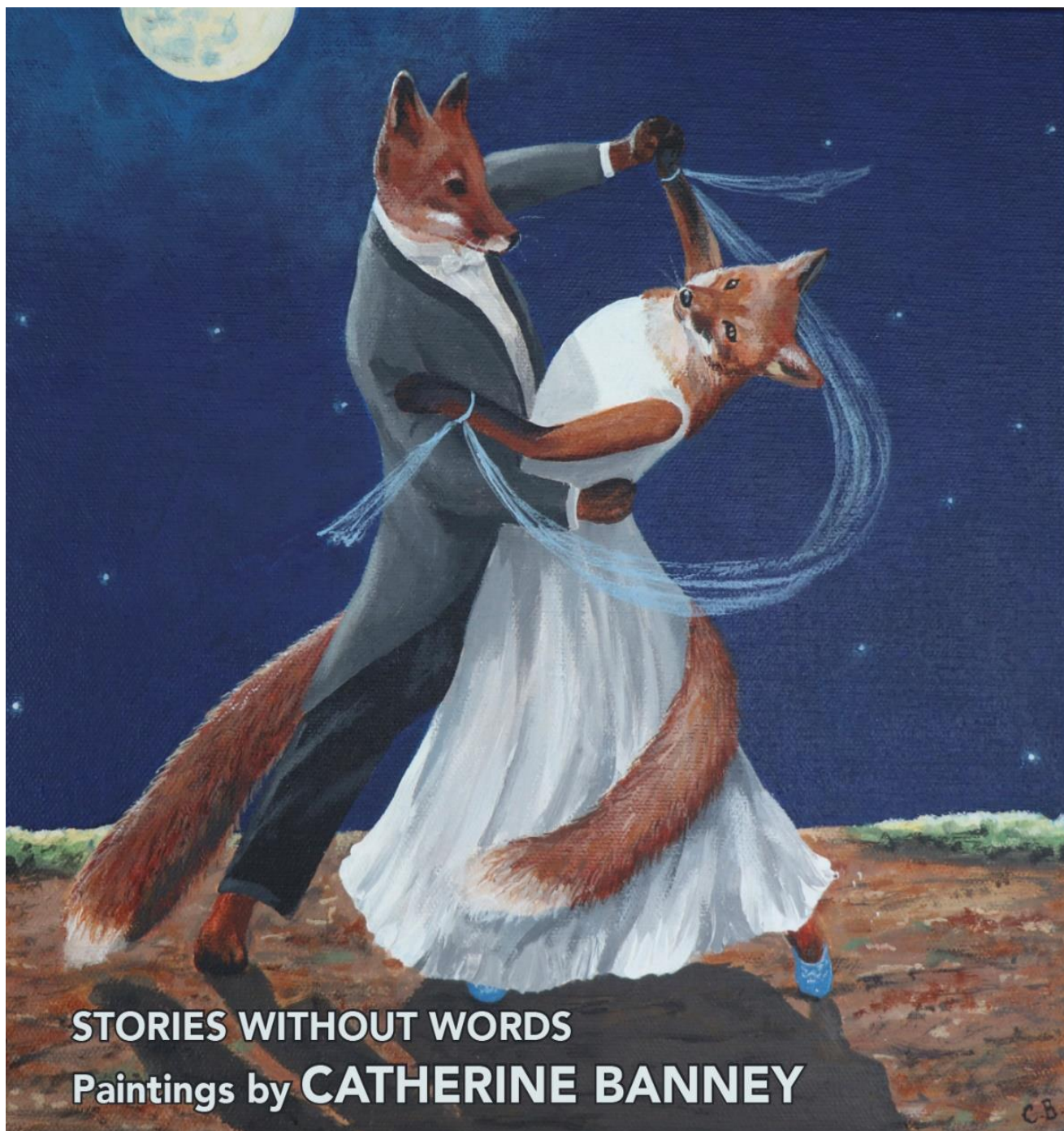
