173 Children are thriving in Out of Home Care foster families

99 people with a disability are living in Samaritans supported accommodation

12,663 people were given emergency relief such as food, vouchers or financial assistance

1,441 young people counselled with mental health support

156 people supported via post-release services to stay drug-free after leaving prison

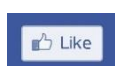
