ABM MISSIONS PROJECT FOR FEBRUARY: GAWURA K TO 6

Gawura is a unique, coeducational Kindergarten to Year 6 day school for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children who live at home with their families. Gawura was established in 2007 by St Andrew's Cathedral School in Sydney in response to systemic underachievement and the clear disparity in educational outcomes of Indigenous and non- Indigenous Australians. Gawura's mission is to break the entrenched cycle of disadvantage experienced by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children As students "graduate" from the Gawura primary program, they are offered scholarships at St Andrew's Cathedral School for their secondary education. In 2017, 3 Gawura students completed year 12 at



secondary education. In 2017, 3 Gawura students completed year 12 at St Andrew's Cathedral School, graduating successfully with the Higher School Certificate.
