

Missions: ABM Project for August Deepening Young People's Faith in Dogura Diocese



This program helps reconnect young people in PNG to their communities. Many young people are affected by drugs and turn to anti-social activities as they suffer from boredom in remote areas. The Church tells ABM that many young people return to belief and practices in sorcery and witchcraft. This project aims to deepen their Christian faith through fellowship, bible study, participation in worship and work in community. It also works to help these young people to

understand that they belong to a family, church and a village. It will be coordinated by a group of young people with a concern in doing something for other youth.
