

# ABM MISSIONS PROJECT FOR JANUARY SOLOMON ISLANDS: DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND CLIMATE CHANGE



This year we aim to demonstrate Backyard Gardening in 5 communities vulnerable to natural disaster and climate change, and to improve drainage at Selwyn College to reduce the impact of flash flooding on the school population. ABM's partner, the Anglican Church of Melanesia (ACOM) places a priority on helping people across the Solomon Islands to be as

resilient as possible in the face of these events, particularly in food production, food security and capacity to respond effectively natural disasters. ACOM will work with selected vulnerable coastal communities to demonstrate and train women in doing Backyard Gardening which increases crop yields and thus reduces vulnerability to climate

change. Women, identified as 'lead gardeners' in their communities, will be shown how to make raised beds and use salt-resistant crops where appropriate, as well as organic gardening techniques such as composting, mulching and pest management. The women will also receive training in nutrition. These 'lead gardeners' will then train others in their communities. The women receive planting materials and tools after the
