Cathedral Board News

The term of office of the Hon John Price AM has concluded and the Board, at its recent meeting, expressed sincere gratitude to him for his contribution to the Cathedral as a Board member.

The Diocese has undergone a major governance review and the Cathedral Ordinance has been amended as one outcome of this.

The Board will now be chaired by an appointee of the Bishop and Mr Phillip Weston (Morpeth Parish) has been appointed to this role. We thank him for taking on this responsibility.

Future decisions about the reconstitution and role of a Cathedral Parish Council have been delegated by the Bishop Administrator and Diocesan Council to the Dean and Board. This includes decisions relating to eligibility for office of previous PC members.

The Twilight Musical Dialogues series is delivered in a deft mix of humour and pathos, with the music unified by each concert's historic and geographic framework. This concert's destination is Russia.
