AUGUST MISSIONS PROJECT: *Newton Theological College - Securing the Future of the Church in PNG* - There is an urgent need for strong leadership throughout the parishes of the Anglican Church of Papua New Guinea. Funding will contribute to Curriculum Development replacing the 1980's curriculum currently in use, teacher development and site maintenance. Supplies like books, water tanks and Master's Degrees for Lecturers are all required. "Newton College is a beautiful place with friendships among the students, but it needs new library books, a better water supply - 24 hour water supply. We also need more qualified lecturers and computers the students can use."
