## **ABM MISSIONS - INDONESIA TSUNAMI EMERGENCY APPEAL**

We watch in horror as the death toll mounts in Sulawesi, Indonesia following a massive earthquake and tsunami that struck on 28 September, 2018. The death toll is close to 2,000 and more than 2,500 people were injured. More than 70,000 homes were destroyed or damaged and more than 75,000 people have been displaced. ABM has launched an appeal to assist



survivors in Sulawesi with immediate relief needs and with rebuilding their homes and livelihoods. ABM funds will be channelled through ACT Alliance which has member agencies based in Indonesia. **ABM is hoping to raise AUD \$20,000 for the disaster response. Please consider a gift to help the many people desperately in need.** Please pray for all whose lives have been lost and affected by this disaster in Indonesia, and also for those who are responding on the ground.
