Missions October Project: Myanmar Emergency Response

ABM has launched an appeal in support of All Churches Together (ACT) Alliance's emergency relief efforts to assist the many Rohingya refugees fleeing from the increasingly violent situation in Myanmar.



We are aiming to raise \$20,000 towards the purchase of humanitarian aid supplies. Funding is urgently needed to provide vital medical care, emergency food, clean water, and hygiene and sanitation kits for the victims of this crisis.
