Message from the Samaritans: Just to let you know that not only has Samaritans been accredited as a White Ribbon Accredited Workplace but it is leading the way locally, as the only Hunter-based workplace to be accredited by White Ribbon thus far. Samaritans has at present approximately 770 staff, with over 600 being women. The safety and wellbeing of all our staff members is paramount and our accreditation achievement is a testament to this. Missions: ABM Project: Lenten/Easter Envelopes and Zambia - Gender and Governance Initiative

The 2013/2014, Zambia Demographic and Health Survey (ZDHS) reports that in Zambia, 43% of women aged 15 – 49 have experienced physical violence since age 15. Poverty indicators also show that Western Province is one of the poorest provinces in Zambia with a staggering 80% of people living in poverty and 60% experiencing extreme poverty with women more affected than men (World Bank, 2015). The overall objective of the Gender and Governance Initiative is to reduce gender imbalances, enhance the empowerment of women in the project sites and promote good governance practices at national and local government levels by encouraging the participation of women in leadership roles. The program also aims to educate people about, and reduce the incidence of, Gender Based Violence. ABM funding supports The Zambia Anglican Council Outreach Program. Lent/Good Friday/Easter envelopes are still available or offerings may be placed in an envelope and marked ABM – Lent.
