Missions ABM Our Project for October: The Solomon Islands - Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Program. The Solomon Islands are increasingly vulnerable to the effects of climate change and natural disasters. In 2015 alone two devastating cyclones affected various islands within the archipelago causing widespread damage and loss of life. ABM is committed to supporting the communities for these increasingly frequent disasters. This involves the implementation of a Disaster Risk Reduction program. King tides, rising water levels and salt intrusion into water supply and crops is causing havoc in the region; all effects which are classed as contributing to a “slow onset disaster”. *[Envelopes are at the rear of the Church]*

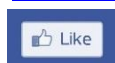
