Message from the Samaritans: Winter is coming to a close however the battle is not yet over for the 26,000 young people who will have no place to call home to-night. CEO of Samaritans, Peter Gardiner is calling on the Hunter Community to support the **Samaritans Winter Appeal** in its final weeks and help address the invisible crisis of youth homelessness. In the final weeks of the **Winter Appeal**, the Samaritans ask that you dig deep and consider the difference your contribution could make in tackling the invisible crisis of youth homelessness. The Cathedral Healing team is organising a special event to mark the beginning of **National Child Protection Week**. Don was involved in developing a response to the widespread abuse in CEBS in South Australia and will talk on the need for cultural conversion as part of the church's response to sexual abuse.

Missions: ABM Project for August - *Deepening Young People's Faith in Dogura Diocese* - This program helps reconnect young people in PNG to their communities. Many young people are affected by drugs and turn to anti-social activities as they suffer from boredom in remote areas. The Church tells ABM that many young people return to belief and practices in sorcery and witchcraft. This project aims to deepen their Christian faith through fellowship, bible study, participation in worship and work in community. It also works

to help these young people to understand that they belong to a family, church and a village. It will be coordinated by a group of young people with a concern in doing something for other youth. *Envelopes are at the back of the Church.*
