AUGUST MISSIONS PROJECT: Newton Theological College - Securing the Future of the Church in PNG - There is an urgent need

for strong leadership throughout the parishes of the Anglican Church of Papua New Guinea. Building on ABM's previous work in PNG and support of Newton College, this is a holistic project aiming to improve learning and living conditions. Funding will contribute to Curriculum Development replacing the 1980's curriculum currently in use, teacher development and site maintenance. Supplies like books, water tanks and Master's Degrees for Lecturers are all required.
