# Missions: ABM Project for August Deepening Young People's Faith in Dogura Diocese

This program helps reconnect young people in PNG to their communities. Many young people are affected by drugs and turn to anti-social activities as they suffer from boredom in remote areas. The Church tells ABM that many young people return to belief and practices in sorcery and witchcraft. This project aims to deepen their Christian faith through fellowship, bible study, participation in worship and work in community. It also works to help these young people to understand that they belong to a family,

church and a village. It will be coordinated by a group of young people with a concern in doing something for other youth. *Envelopes inside this week's pew sheet.* 

**The Cathedral Healing team** is organising a special event to mark the beginning of **National Child Protection Week.** At **6pm on Sunday 3 September**, there will be a shortened Evensong followed by a presentation by Dr Don Owers with an opportunity for questions and answers and a light supper. Don was involved in developing a response to the widespread abuse in CEBS in South Australia and will talk on the need for cultural conversion as part of the church's response to sexual abuse.
