### **ABM Missions – Mission Project for May – Solomon Islands**

***Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change*** - During the last year, the Anglican Church of Melanesia (ACOM) installed eight new water tanks using ABM funding, as part of their Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change response work. The St Claire Rural Health Clinic, located in the Central Island Province of the Solomon Islands, was



one of the recipients. The Health Clinic has been tirelessly serving the people of the province for many years, both Anglican and non-Anglican, caring for the sick despite the challenges of limited resources and access to clean water. Your ongoing support is needed.

*The beautiful coastlines of the Solomon Islands are being affected by the effects of long term climate change.*

**Missions - Our own missionaries** - ABM's work in the mission fields has changed over the years. Missionaries were often trained at The House of the Epiphany in Stanmore Sydney to go to places mainly in the Pacific region e.g., New Guinea, Fiji, Melanesia etc. Today most of these dioceses are mainly staffed by their own people as a result of the work of the earlier missionaries. We give thanks to God for those in our church community who served on the mission fields - Fr Mel and Vivienne Nelson in Fiji, Jan Kitchingman in the Solomon Islands and Fr Philip and Margaret Thirlwell in Fiji, Japan and other places.
