Message from the Samaritans: Samaritans Tenancy Resource Team (STRT), in partnership in with FACS and tenants, installed a rain water tank at Social Housing units in Bar Beach on April 27. STRT has supported the community garden project, called "Artscape" within the complex that was started by the tenants. The new water tanks will be used to water and complement their sustainable garden practices. For those who are unable to grow their own vegies they rely on your generous donations of tinned fruit and vegies as well as long life milk, fruit juices, cereals, tea and coffee.

Zambia - Gender and Governance Initiative

The 2013/2014, Zambia Demographic and Health Survey (ZDHS) reports that in Zambia, 43% of women aged 15 – 49 have experienced physical violence since age 15. Poverty indicators also show that Western Province is one of the poorest provinces in Zambia with a staggering 80% of people living in poverty and 60% experiencing extreme poverty with women more affected than men (World Bank, 2015). The program also aims to educate people about, and reduce the incidence of, Gender Based Violence. ABM funding supports The Zambia Anglican Council Outreach Program.

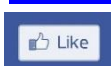
