

Situated on top of the Hill, overlooking Newcastle, Christ Church Cathedral is one of the most recognisable and prominent buildings in our city. For its entire history the cathedral has proudly supported, and been enriched by, a fine tradition of music, involving organ, choirs and orchestras.

In 2014, Christ Church Cathedral is establishing a new choir for students aged 15-18: the Cathedral Youth Chorale. This choir will further develop abilities in singing and musicianship, and is a great way to gain hands-on experience of working in an ensemble, while improving music reading and aural skills. It's also a fantastic opportunity to meet other young people that share a passion for singing!

More about the Youth Chorale ...

The Cathedral Youth Chorale's focus will be on learning a wide variety of music- from spirtuals to contemporary songs and anthems, ranging back to Gregorian Chant and plainsong. Repertoire will be drawn from Australia, North and South America, Europe and the United Kingdom, The Chorale will sing unaccompanied, and with organ and piano. Members of the choir that play instruments will be encouraged to participate in a number of collaborative projects and those with a flair for composition will have the opportunity to write for the choir.

The Youth Chorale will sing for a service once a month within the Cathedral. This will encompass performances with the Chorale only, joining with the Cathedral Choir for special ocassions, and at other times displaying leadership in working with the Cathedral's St Nicholas Choir. Rehearsal for The Youth Chorale will be on Thursdays during term from 4-5:30pm.
