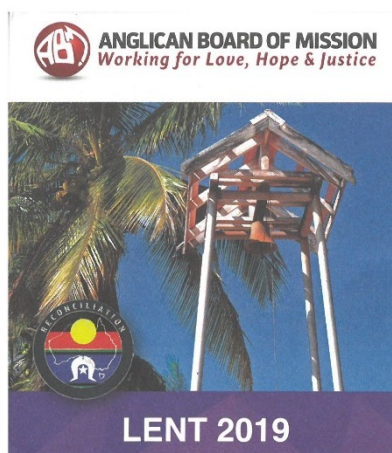


## ABM MISSIONS 2019 LENT APPEAL
