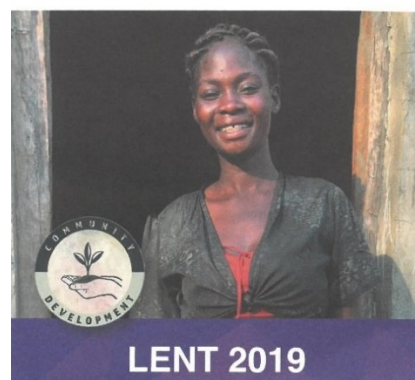

**GENDER & GOVERNANCE INITIATIVE IN ZAMBIA** - ABM works with the Zambia Anglican Council Outreach Program (ZACOP) to end child marriage and to end the conditions of poverty and ignorance, and the low status of women that sustain it. ZACOP is educating people about the rights of women and children, helping them to claim these rights, and providing services to support victims of gender-based violence (GBV). Violet (pictured above), aged 28, is a survivor of domestic violence. With the support of her Village Counselling Centre, she found the courage to change her life around, and those of her children. She is now a convenor of a Savings with Education group. With her savings and borrowings she bought vegetable seeds and has developed a small business which supports her and her children. Please support this project and make a difference to the lives of women like Violet and their children in Zambia, by helping ABM's partner continue its programs in the Eastern Province.
