OUR CHOIR'S MINISTRY - Fr Robert Catt was present at St Luke's, Wallsend 150th Anniversary celebrations on 9 September when members of the Cathedral Choir sang Festal Evensong. He describes the singing as 'brilliant' and reports that the choir was greatly appreciated and highly praised by those in attendance. He reminds us all that it would be too easy for us as Cathedral parishioners to take our choir for granted and concludes: 'I hope that the wonderful witness and faithfulness of the Cathedral Organists and Choristers might be acknowledged. May we offer thanks to God for their significant contribution and ministry not only to the Cathedral but to the wider church and community. Congratulations to all!'

Message from the Samaritans: CEO Mr Peter Gardiner says the Government's proposed welfare changes are unlikely to improve the well-being of people in need and will likely see increased inequality and disadvantage in Australia, cumulating to further poverty. Australia is facing growing inequality where the cost of living is rising faster than wages or government payments. Inequality is now the worst it has been in 75 years, in spite of two decades of uninterrupted economic growth. In the Hunter region there are nearly five disadvantaged job seekers for every vacancy at their skill level. There are simply not enough jobs/hours to cater for the number of people who are looking for work.
