*Envelopes are inserted in the pew sheet or at the back of the church. Please place your envelope with your details in the plate or in the wall safe at the back of the cathedral.*



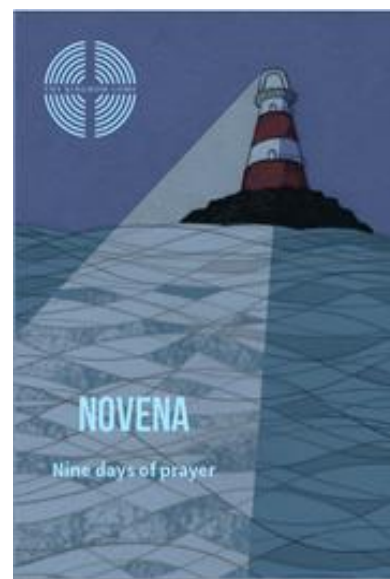
\* **PRAY** that as young people prepare for the colder winter months that they would have provision for both warm winter clothing, food and a safe place to stay.
