Message from the Samaritans: Peter Gardiner, CEO of the Samaritans Foundation, recently wrote an article on last week's Budget for the Newcastle Herald and a precis of this follows: "*...The biggest win from the 2017 budget was the government's move to secure the future of the NDIS through the Medicare Levy and there was also welcome news of investment in the mental health space. Gifts of or towards Pentecost frontal - Over the last few years we have been gifted with frontals for every season except, at this point, Pentecost and the white/gold seasons. Jan Clarke, our fabric artist, is now creating a red altar frontal in time for Pentecost. There is a flyer at the back of the Cathedral with details and a drawing of the new frontal and explaining how to donate or contribute to it. If you would like to contribute to the gold frontal that would also be welcome and would complete our set. The red and gold frontals don't necessarily require matching vestments unless there are donors who would like to provide them.

Missions: ABM Project: Zambia - Gender and Governance Initiative

The 2013/2014, Zambia Demographic and Health Survey (ZDHS) reports that in Zambia, 43% of women aged 15 – 49 have experienced physical violence since age 15. Poverty indicators also show that Western Province is one of the poorest provinces in Zambia with a staggering 80% of people living in poverty and 60% experiencing extreme poverty with women more affected than men (World Bank, 2015). The program also aims to educate people about, and reduce the incidence of, Gender Based Violence. ABM funding supports The Zambia Anglican Council Outreach Program.
