Missions: ABM Project: Easter Envelopes and Zambia - Gender and Governance Initiative

The 2013/2014, Zambia Demographic and Health Survey (ZDHS) reports that in Zambia, 43% of women aged 15 – 49 have experienced physical violence since age 15. Poverty indicators also show that Western Province is one of the poorest provinces in Zambia with a staggering 80% of people living in poverty and 60% experiencing extreme poverty with women more affected than men (World Bank, 2015). The overall objective of the Gender and Governance Initiative is to reduce gender imbalances, enhance the empowerment of women in the project sites and promote good governance practices at national and local government levels by encouraging the participation of women in leadership roles. The program also aims to educate people about, and reduce the incidence of, Gender Based Violence. ABM funding supports The Zambia Anglican Council Outreach Program.

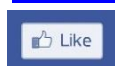
