Church Capacity Building for Development

In July 2016, a Capacity Building workshop was held with the Anglican Church of Melanesia (ACOM), ABM's partner in the Solomon Islands. The workshop was for ACOM's Heads of Department, Treasurers and Commercial Holdings Managers to further enhance their existing knowledge and skills. The training was attended by 39 people (including 16 women) from the dioceses of Malaita, Isabel, Temotu, Makira, Guadalcanal and Honiara. This investment allows the Church in the Solomon Islands to continue its community development work effectively and efficiently.
