

ABM MISSIONS - INDONESIA TSUNAMI EMERGENCY APPEAL

We watch in horror as the death toll mounts in Sulawesi, Indonesia following a massive earthquake and tsunami that struck on 28 September, 2018. The death toll is already over 1,200 and is likely to be much greater as search teams comb through rubble and travel to more remote coastal villages. More than 48,000 people have been displaced, with assessments ongoing, and more than 191,000 people are in "urgent need" of humanitarian assistance. ABM has launched an appeal to assist survivors in Sulawesi with immediate relief needs and with rebuilding their homes and livelihoods. ABM funds will be channelled through ACT Alliance which has member agencies based in Indonesia.





ABM is hoping to raise AUD \$20,000 for the disaster response. Please consider a gift to help the many people desperately in need.
