In the Diocese of Jerusalem, the Princess Basma Centre for children with disabilities is providing a series of quality, specialised and comprehensive rehabilitation services. These services are for children that are less fortunate and cannot afford the services elsewhere.

The program is accompanied by a Mothers' Empowerment Program which also requires assistance through funding. In this program, mothers receive specialised psychosocial support, recreational activities, and educational workshops on different health issues related to disabilities and rights of children with disabilities. They also attend every therapy session with their children and are trained by the therapists on performing the activities when they return back home.

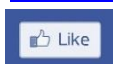
