Message from the Samaritans: Peter Gardiner, CEO of the Samaritans CEO blogs....*the Hunter is currently tackling an alarming problem with the use of crystal methamphetamine ("ice") rising at double the rate of the rest of NSW. Over the past two years, in Lake Macquarie alone, the possession or use of amphetamines has increased by 77.6%. Our Recovery Point program provides people exiting correctional and rehabilitation centres with ongoing support to assist them to stay drug free in the community. One of the key factors in the success of this program is its holistic approach towards rehabilitation.....Last year over 150 people received ongoing support. However with more funding we could assist many more!* We thank you for your ongoing contributions of food of pastas, cereals, long life milk, noodles, tea and coffee.

Missions ABM Our Project for October: The Solomon Islands - Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Program. The Solomon Islands are increasingly vulnerable to the effects of climate change and natural disasters. In 2015 alone two devastating cyclones affected various islands within the archipelago causing widespread damage and loss of life. ABM is committed to supporting the communities for these increasingly frequent disasters. This involves the implementation of a Disaster Risk Reduction program. King tides, rising water levels and salt intrusion into water supply and crops is causing havoc in the region; all effects which are classed as contributing to a "slow onset disaster". *[Envelopes are at the rear of the Church]*

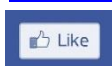
